If you cannot otherwise conduct legal research, you may register one time only for a temporary Lexis Advance® ID. You will receive an ID within 1 business day valid for 30 days. This ID allows you to conduct research on the cases and codes needed for legal work and personal legal research. We are happy to work with you to maintain access to justice during this time.
